

The Atholl Highlanders

This Bagpipe March was composed for the Duke of Atholl's regiment, which is the only private army in Britain. Normally heard in the pipe key of A (the pipe scale has a flattened 7th) it is a very popular tune and is often heard played as a jig.

Watch out for the chords.... "E" has a G# in it, but in the 3rd & 4th parts set your G's to natural to play a normal G chord.
